- Land formerly comprised a derelict mineral extraction site secured for CRE Energy Limited (part of the Scottish Power Group) for major wind farm facility
- Phase 1 comprising 42 turbines, which has sufficient capacity to meet the electricity needs of 70,000 homes each year
- Clients applied for Planning Permission to the Scottish Executive and approval now obtained, phase 2 installation Summer 2007 for additional 12 turbines. this development too is now complete and operational
- The completed scheme provides in excess of 100 megawatts of power
- Hawksmoor negotiated terms for an option and lease with the landowner who controlled the access to the site and whose land provides an important source of material used to build site access roads for the whole of the development
